committee member application. If you are currently a volunteer, you will follow the steps below. If you are not currently a 4-H volunteer, you will need to go through the process of becoming a 4-H volunteer, in addition to the steps listed below.

How to Join a Livestock Committee:

- Turn in your application and select the desired committee
- The Medina 4-H Extension Educator reviews application
- Your name is added to your desired committee list
- Medina County Junior Fair Committee of the Medina County Senior Fair Board votes on membership
- Fair Board approved committee members then approve membership on the desired committee

To Become a 4-H Volunteer you must:

- Attend an interview with the 4-H professional
- Create a 4-H online account as a volunteer
- Complete a background check
- Submit 3 references
- Complete New Volunteer Orientation

Please note: General volunteer applications will open in December. The current application period is for committees.

Pre-Fair Committee Applications Open:

This year, when applying for committees, you can apply for Pre-Fair committees and Livestock committees. This includes:

- Dog Committee
- Family and Consumer Sciences Committees
- Pet Animal Committee
- Still Exhibits Committee





What do they do? Pre-Fair committees are responsible for planning and running our Pre-Fair Judging nights in cooperation with the Extension office. Committees make rule recommendations, distribute awards, select judges, decorate exhibit barns, and promote non-livestock projects.

How much of a time commitment is this? Pre-Fair Committees have just a few meetings each year with the bulk of work happening May-July. Individual committee members need to be present at

judging night and for set up. Other meeting dates and requirements are set by the individual committees.

CARTEENS Fall Workshop – October 12th

Join CARTEENS and make a difference! There has never been a better time to join the CARTEENS

Once we are done training, you will have the chance to test the information by assisting with the CARTEENS Class, a peer-led course for first-time traffic offenders. Who: Youth 14-18 years old

Why: Vehicle crashes are the #1 cause of death for teens. The CARTEENS program seeks to save lives through education. CARTEENS participation also counts towards volunteer service hours.

When: Fall workshop will run from 3-5pm, with class to follow 5:30-7:30pm. Dinner will be

provided. Classes are offered twice a month for two hours and volunteers can attend as many or as few classes as works for them.

Junior Fair Board Applications Now Open- Due Nov 1

Interested in Joining the Medina County



Junior Fair Board? Applications are open now until November 1st! Must be 13 or older to be a member. Youth 11 to 12 may apply as associate members only.

Jr Fair Board is a board made up of 4H or FFA members between 13 and 18 years as of January 1 of the upcoming

year. Applicants must have been a Junior Fair Organization member for at least one year before applying for membership. Youth 11-13 years of age may join as associate members of the Jr. Fair Board. Associate Members participate in all aspects of a regular member but may not hold an office or service as committee chairs.

As a member individuals will participate in Community Service projects, fundraising, and promotional opportunities. Members also help with judging before and during the fair, helping

by announcing, passing out ribbons, and recording results. As well as helping with passing out fair passes and the livestock sale. During the meetings, members plan activities for youth to participate in during the fair from brainstorming ideas, to finding sponsors, to advertising and finalizing details.

Every year, members put on an event for individuals with developmental disabilities called Fair Friends, showing them what it is like to participate in the fair. Members find sponsors, and plan stations for individuals to go through.

Scholarship criteria: The Medina County Jr. Leadership 4-H Club scholarship was established in 2006. This award recognizes up to two senior members who have exhibited exceptional integrity and outstanding service while **enrolled as members of the Medina County Jr. Leadership 4-H Club.** Up to two \$500 scholarships will be awarded based on the judgment of an independent selection committee's evaluations of the applicants. Scholarship monies will be awarded to the winner(s) of the award(s). Application is due by November 15th.

Tractor Safety Certification Registration Open

Medina County will once again hold its yearly Tractor Safety Certification SPIN Club. The course will be held on Saturday mornings, February 3rd to March 16th. 

Background:

Founded in 1945 as part of The Ohio State University Development Fund, the Ohio 4-H Foundation solicits and receives contributions on behalf of Ohio 4-H in order to enhance the 4-H Youth Development Program, promotes the Ohio 4-H Youth Development program and recognizes 4-H members and adult volunteers. The Ohio 4-H Foundation established an Endowment in 1946 in order to create a permanent investment. With private support from individuals, businesses and organizations, the Ohio 4-H Foundation is able to fund new programs and improve existing programs at the county, region, and state levels. Annual program grants are awarded by the Foundation to support innovative programs, meet emerging, local needs or pilot new efforts. Thus, the support of donors throughout Ohio is vital to our success.

Today:

The Ohio 4-H Foundation is guided by a volunteer Board, comprised of business and industry leaders, Extension personnel, and 4-H youth representatives from around the state. The Board reviews proposals and distributes endowment interest income for the training of volunteer leadership and the recognition of 4-H members through scholarships, awards and positive youth development experiences.

Here are specific responsibilities of board members:

- Attend three face-to-face meetings that are held throughout the state or by Zoom (one in January, one in spring, one in fall).
- Serve on a committee. The committees typically meet one time a month via Zoom (often times the committees meet during the day).
- Assist with the Celebration of Youth fundraiser preparations.
- Voice youth perspectives in every avenue to all board members and youth throughout the state.

Each year, current members in good standing have been given the privilege of representing Ohio 4-H on the Ohio 4-H Foundation Board. This year, we will select one member to serve a two-year term. The term is from January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2025.
