# What to pack:

Our camp is almost all outdoors with lots of shared space. We recommend that you label all clothes and items taken to camp. We are not responsible for items that are lost and not found, including money.

### WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Flashlight
- Pillow
- Twin Extra Long Sheets and Sleeping Bag
- Camp Clothing- Shorts or pants, capris, tank tops, t-shirts, socks, underwear,
- pajamas
- Sweatshirt or Jacket
- One or two pairs of old, comfortable, closed-toe shoes for walking, hiking, and running (flip-flops (Slides) not permitted, except for shower or beach)
- Flip flops (slides), shower shoes, or wading shoes (for shower and beach only)
- Modest Swimsuit one or two piece (without strings that can be easily undone)
- Towel for Beach
- Minimum of 2 Towels & Wash Cloths for shower
- Toiletry articles (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, etc.)
- Refillable water bottle with your name on it
- Raincoat (let's hope we don't need it!)
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Chapstick with Sunscreen
- Laundry bag or garbage bag to stuff dirty clothes and laundry in
- Camp Bank Money for canteen snacks (A maximum of \$5.00 per day for snacks. There will also be Kelleys Island merchandise for sale that will be around \$20.00-\$30.00 each)
- OPTIONAL ITEMS TO BRING: Disposable cameras, Hats, Sunglasses


## NOT PERMITTED TO BE BROUGHT TO CAMP


- X Extra food items including candy (unless described on medical form for dietary restrictions). We can store those items in a separate refrigerator for meal times and snacks.
