

Rabbit Important Dates & Deadlines

Online Entry will be open April 17-June 1, 11:59 pm. Late Entry (SHOWMANSHIP ONLY) will be open June 2-June 15, 11:59 pm.

PROJECT SELECTION

Project 225 Breeding Rabbit—stays at the fair, rabbits are judged in breed class; also includes doe & litter class.

Project 226 Market Rabbit—stays at the fair, also includes individual fryer class. Quality Assurance training is required.

Project 227 Pet Rabbit— does not stay at the fair. Project 227 is judged on July 11, at the Community Center from 3:00-5:00 pm., rabbit come to judging; poster or scrapbook stays for exhibition. Pet Rabbit division winners may be eligible for State Fair Participation on Companion Animal Day.

Jr. Fair Entry required for ALL PROJECTS. NOTE: A Rabbit entered in project 225, cannot be entered in project 227.

Note: Every market livestock and carcass exhibitor is required to complete a 2019 Quality Assurance Training. If an exhibitor is under the age of 18 on the date of training, the exhibitor's parent/guardian is also required to attend a 2019 Quality Assurance Training. Quality Assurance Training must be completed by June 1 prior to fair.
