

2019 Performance Against Standards/State Qualifying Shows of Northeast Ohio

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- All 4-H youth wishing to participate in Horse Shows at the Ohio State Fair must qualify at the county level.
- Each youth is limited to four classes. The four classes may be any of the classes offered at State Fair.
- A youth may only use one horse to try out in PAS shows and cannot replace a horse for any reason after they show in their first PAS class.
- A youth must qualify in any two classes in order to compete in the State Fair Junior Horse Show.
- Youth do NOT need to qualify in their home county. HOWEVER, it is the youth's responsibility to pre-register and complete the Out of County Verification Form prior to the event and return it to their County Office.
