

## 2019 Assuring Quality Care for Animals/Quality Assurance Programs of Northeast Ohio

All Junior Fair and 4-H youth taking marketable and/or lactating livestock projects must attend an Ohio Quality Assurance Program. Below is a list of QA dates within the WREERA.

4-H members wishing to attend a Quality Assurance program outside of their own county **MUST** pre-register with their own county. The home county 4-H staff will register 4-H member with the desired county Quality Assurance program.

Youth must be in attendance for the entire program. Signed documentation by the Quality Assurance instructor of out-of-county attendance is the responsibility of the 4-H member as proof of participation.
