## State Fair Qualifying Shows (PAS)

One (1) Performance Against Standards (PAS) show is offered in Medina County. If an exhibitor fails to qualify at the **June 8, 2019** PAS Show, the member can show in another county. You will need to check with the Extension Office for the other county show dates.

Detailed rules and State Fair Schedule can be obtained from the Extension Office.

1. There are no placings. Each exhibitor will be given a score on their performance based on a 100 point scale or timed for Gymkhana events. Exhibitors who score at or above the qualifying score or time will go on to state competition. Scores will be posted soon after the class. This will enable the exhibitor to see how various parts of the performance were scored to reach the final total.
2. Each exhibitor may show in up to 4 declared PAS classes. The exhibitor **must qualify in 2 classes** in order to show at the State Fair. Four classes may be listed if the exhibitor qualified. Be sure to check the State Fair Schedule to avoid conflicts.
3. Exhibitor may take only one **1** project horse to the State Fair and it **must be declared on the PAS Signup Form**. You will also register for your classes on the same form. **There will be no registration at the show.**
  - The PAS Signup Form is due in the Extension Office by 5:00 pm, **June 1. There will be no exceptions to this deadline!**
  - **An Advisor's Signature is required to be a completed form.**
4. The horse you take as a State Fair project and/or backup animal **MUST** be identified as a project or backup animal on the Junior Fair Horse Entry Form at the Extension Office by 5:00 pm, June 1.

### COUNCIL

5. At the time a horse is shown in a PAS Class it becomes the State Fair Project and cannot be changed for any reason.
6. There will be an Entry Fee per class to be paid at the beginning of the PAS Show.
7. All State Fair Qualifiers who exhibit their horse at the State Fair are eligible to show in the Championship Show in the 2-4 classes that they showed in regardless of their placings in the Medina County Fair (must show same horse in a Fair Week Class).
  - If the exhibitor chooses not to go to State Fair after they qualify and do not place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, or 5<sup>th</sup> in their Fair Week Classes they **are not eligible for the Championship Show.**
