<u>Counselors</u>: 25 Medina County 4-H Teen Members participate in over 20 hours of training in preparation for camp; plus the adult summer staff for Kelleys Island 4-H Camp will provide supervision and training.

<u>Adult Staff</u>: 4-H approved volunteers and Ohio State University Staff will be on site for the duration of camp.

<u>Nurse</u>: A nurse will be on duty. Parents or guardians will fill out a Health History Form which will be on file with the Camp Nurse during the week.

<u>Camp Fee:</u> \$240 (early bird \$225 with online registration by April 15* and fee rec'd by April 19th). This can be divided in 2 payments, however a \$125 deposit is required and full payment must be made by May 15.

<u>Camp Fee Covers</u>: 1) 3 meals a day and 1 evening snack prepared in accordance with sound nutritional guidelines, 2) Cabin lodging with bunk beds, 3) Restrooms with flush toilets and showers nearby, 4) Camp t-Shirt, and 5) Ferry Ride. Campers are encouraged to bring <u>less</u> than \$20 to camp for use in the Canteen

<u>Insurance</u>: Each camper is covered by a group policy which will provide secondary coverage to supplement any medical insurance carried by your family.

What You'll Learn: This overnight camp will allow youth to learn about themselves and the world around them through hands-on application while making new friends.

<u>Activities</u>: Fishing, snorkeling, canoeing, hiking, crafts, conservation, archery, swimming in Lake Erie, recreational games, and special programs. A certified lifeguard will be on duty at all times during water activities.

<u>Additional Information</u>: Will be emailed no later than May 17th including instructions for campers to select sessions. Session selection must be complete by 5:00pm on May 24 or campers will be assigned sessions.
