What is "good standing" in 4-H?

A member in "good standing" is someone who has completed all the requirements to participate in 4-H. Only members in good standing will receive a free fair pass. To be considered a member in good standing in Medina County 4-H you need to:

- 1. Pay your \$15 yearly dues (max of \$45 per family)
- 2. Take at least one project per club (max of 10 projects)
- 3. Attend 50% or more of your clubs' meetings (but no less than 4 per year)
- 4. Follow all the rules in the 4-H Code of Conduct

1 ENROLL AT OH.4HONLINE.COM

Everyone needs to enroll each year in 4-H Online. Go to https://oh.4honline.com and log in. Click the words "Enroll Now" beside the person's name. Check that all information is correct. Add the projects you will take for 2023. Hit "Submit" by April 17th.

TURN IN \$15 DUES TO YOUR CLUB

You will give your \$15 dues to your club leader and review the code of conduct. Your advisor will then turn in one check for your entire club. Once we receive confirmation your dues were paid you will be approved.

3 ORDER PROJECT BOOKS

There are three ways to order books in Medina County this year. With your club, online at extensionpubs.osu.edu, or stop in to purchase books available in the extension office.

4 ENTER FAIR AT FAIRENTRY.COM

Fair Entry will open on April 18th and close on June 1st. You must complete fair entry in order to show any project at the Medina County Fair. Go to https://fairentry.com to register

2023 Horse Program Requirements

EquiSTEP

As a reminder, ALL members taking a horse project in 2023 must complete the EquiSTEP Program online. EquiSTEP is an annual statewide requirement for all youth participating in Ohio 4-H Horse Program activities. EquiSTEP is designed to be completed online by each participant individually through Scarlet Canvas or administered in a group setting by a county 4-H educator to their participants, like QA (Quality Assurance) for livestock market projects.


Market Goats Possession Deadline May 1




