

Medina County Junior Fair Livestock Sale Committee

Advanced Education Scholarship

In an effort to recognize the quality youth participating in the Medina County Junior Fair Livestock Sale and to help those interested in furthering their education, the Medina County Junior Fair Livestock Sale Committee has established a Scholarship Program.

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist high school seniors (spring graduates from the current year) and graduates who are continuing their education at an accredited institution in an undergraduate course of study in any field.

One scholarship will be awarded to Junior Fair Livestock Sale participants during the sale for a total of \$500. Applicants will be judged on scholastic standing, community service, leadership, and Medina County Fair participation.

RULES:

1. The applicant must be a high school senior who is graduating in the current year or is a high school graduate continuing their education at an accredited institution and has been an active participant in the Medina County Jr. Fair Livestock Sale for at least 5 years before the application is made.
2. Applicant must be eligible to be a participant in the Medina County Junior Fair (not older than 18 years of age as of January 1 of the current year) and still be eligible to show at the Medina County Fair. *To qualify, Applicant must be a current Medina County Jr. Fair participant with an entry in the current year's Livestock Sale.
3. All questions on the application form must be answered to be considered for an award.
4. All applications and parts thereof must be submitted and received by the Medina County Jr. Fair Livestock Sale Committee no later than **5:00 pm, June 15.**
5. Applications will be judged on the following basis:

Scholastic/academics	10%
Community service.....	20%
Leadership	20%
Fair/livestock participation.....	50%
6. Applicants may be required to be interviewed at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
7. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to NOT issue a scholarship, if no applicant fulfills the requirements.
8. Previous winners are not eligible to compete. An exhibitor may win a scholarship only once.
9. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the college after the livestock sale.
