Enrollment Due SOON! April 17th

General 4-H enrollment ends April 17th .All 4-H members need to enroll in 4-H online. Members not enrolled by the deadline will be ineligible for livestock projects in 2023 and can only take one project to fair.

Frequently asked questions:

- Who must enroll in 4-H? All Volunteers and youth members who wish to participate in 2023 must reenroll. Enrollment is required each year.
- What should I do if I forgot my password? You can reset your password if you know the phone number you used to enroll. We can also help you reset your password over the phone.
- What should I do if I forget my username/email? DO NOT create a new account! If you have forgotten the email address you used to register, if you no longer have access to that email, or need to change it, call the extension office for help. Attempting to enter a different email address will create a duplicate account and prevent you from enrolling. 330-661-6405.
- -What are the enrollment fees? County yearly dues are \$15 dues with a family maximum of \$45. Members are responsible for turning in their dues to their club leaders each year along with any required paperwork.

-What is "good standing" in 4-H?

A member in "good standing" is someone who has completed all the requirements to participate in 4-H. Only members in good standing will receive a free fair pass. To be considered a member in good standing in Medina County 4-H you need to:

- 1. Pay your \$15 yearly dues (max of \$45 per family)
- 2. Take at least one project per club (max of 10 projects)
- 3. Attend 50% or more of your clubs' meetings (but no less than 4 per year)
- 4. Follow all the rules in the 4-H Code of Conduct

1 ENROLL AT OH.4HONLINE.COM

Everyone needs to enroll each year in 4-H Online. Go to https://oh.4honline.com and log in. Click the words "Enroll Now" beside the person's name. Check that all information is correct. Add the projects you will take for 2023. Hit "Submit" by April 17th.

TURN IN \$15 DUES TO YOUR CLUB

You will give your \$15 dues to your club leader and review the code of conduct. Your advisor will then turn in one check for your entire club. Once we receive confirmation your dues were paid you will be approved.

3 ORDER PROJECT BOOKS



4TH H CLUB CHALLENGE
